

Tardy Policy

1. One unexcused tardy will result in lunch detention.
 - a. If student arrives late in lunch detention, he/she will finish the day in ISS.
 - b. If the student doesn't show up at all for lunch detention, two hours of Saturday school.
 - c. If the student is disruptive or generally uncooperative in lunch detention he/she will have two hours of Saturday school.
 - d. If the student shows up late to Saturday school, another two hours will be added.
 - e. If the student is disruptive or generally uncooperative in Saturday school, he/she will be sent home, and will be assigned four hours of Saturday school for the following week.
 - f. If the student doesn't show up to Saturday school, he/she will have four hours of Saturday school for the following week.
 - g. If the student fails to comply with the above provision, he/she will be suspended out of school for one day, receive a behavior and/or attendance contract, and spend two days in ISS.
2. Two unexcused tardies will result in two hours of Saturday school.
3. Three unexcused tardies will result in four hours of Saturday school.
4. Anything beyond three unexcused tardies will result in the student being declared habitually late. Consequences for that will be at the discretion of the deans and could include: ISS, Saturday school, out-of-school suspension and the use of behavior/attendance contracts.
