- In each pathway the student earns 24 credit hours at the Community College of Aurora toward an AAS degree in Graphic Design. The Web pathway earns the student a certificate in Web Design<sup>2</sup>. This certificate is designed for those who want to design and maintain the front-end of web sites.
  - The AAS degree consists of a total of 60 credit hours. 15 credits in general education, 22 credits in the art & design core, and 23 credits in the graphic design curriculum.
